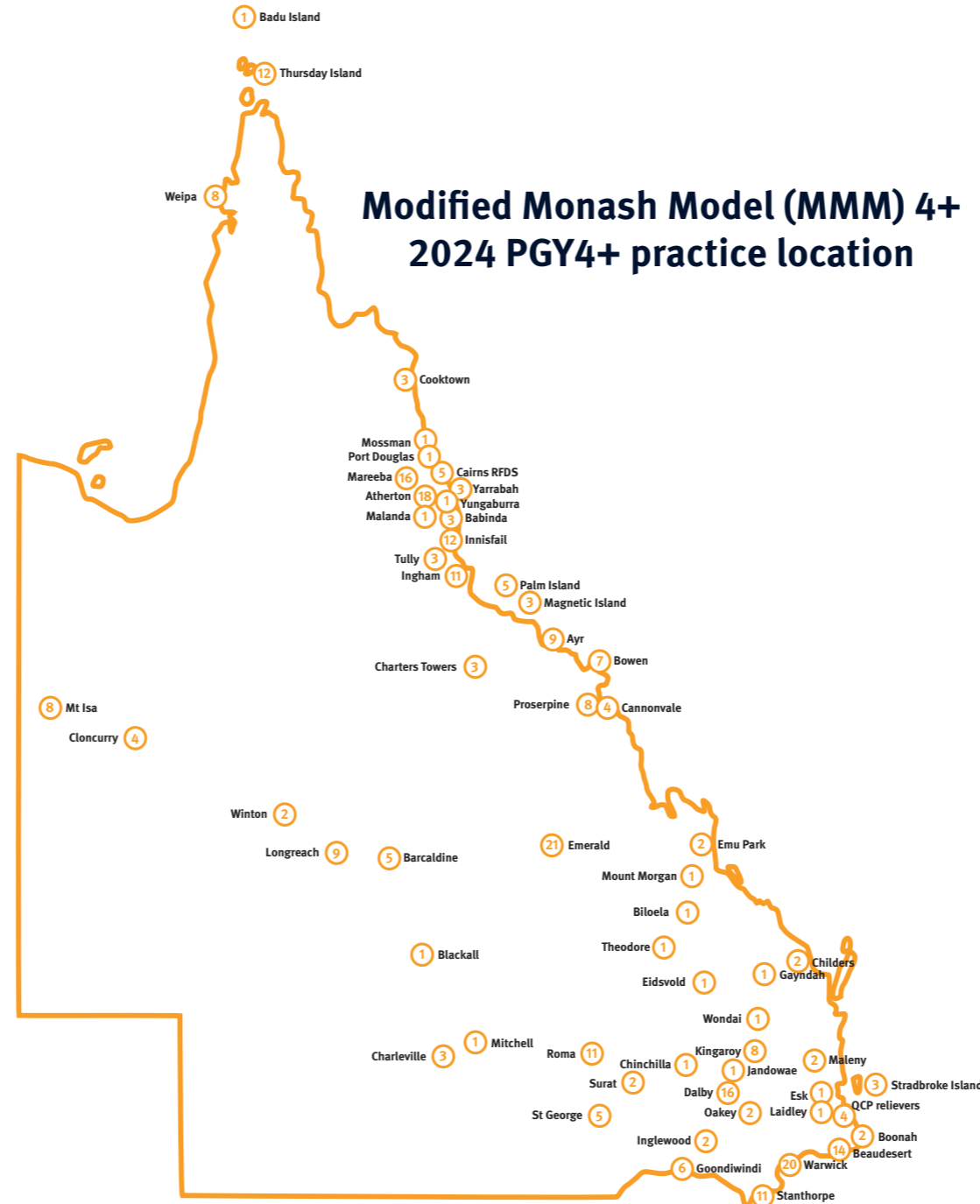

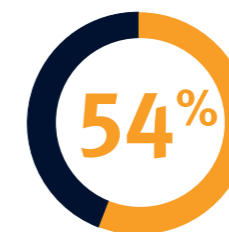

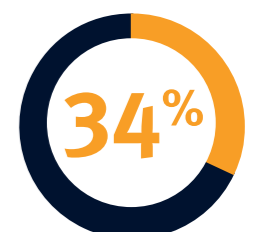
PGY4+ practice type

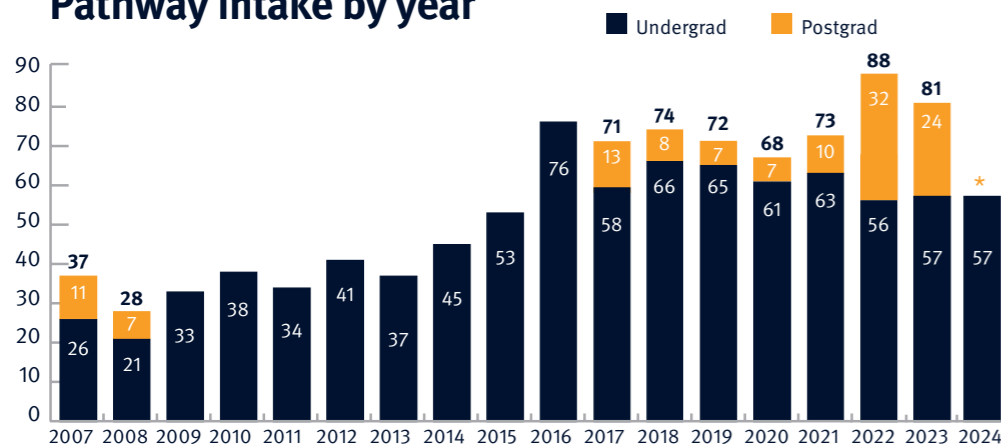

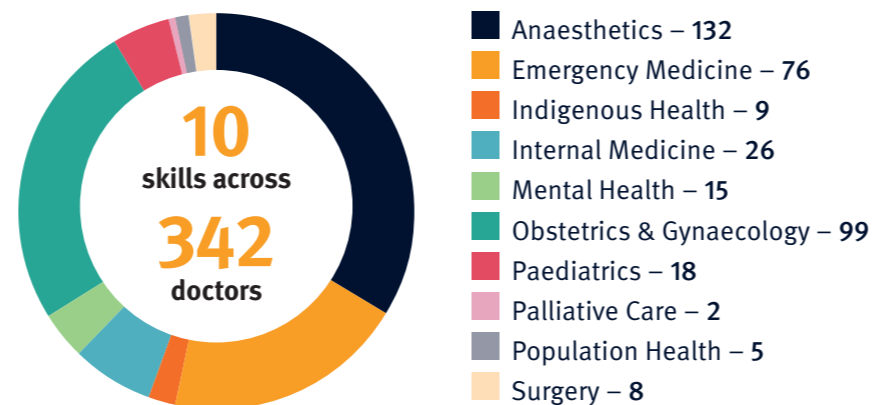

Pathway intake by year

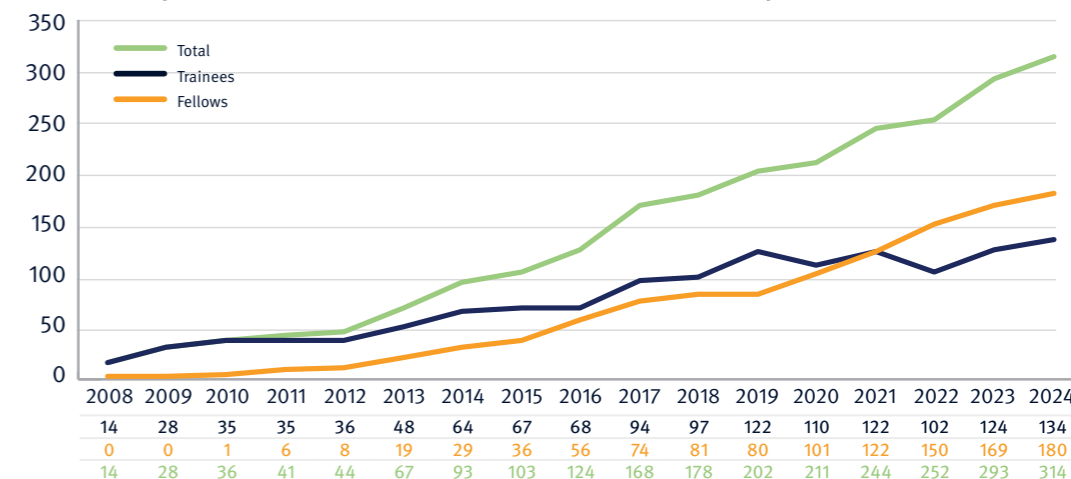

Completed advanced skills by discipline



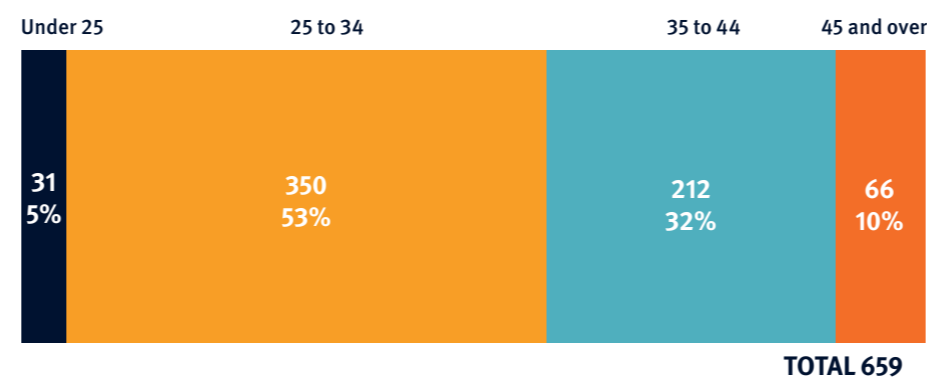

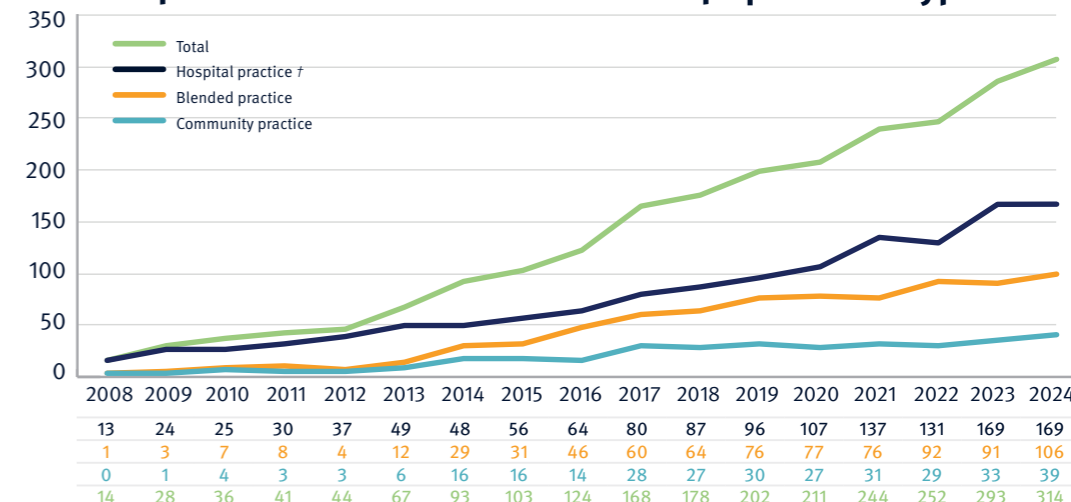

PGY4+ Trainees and Fellows in MMM4+ | Practice type

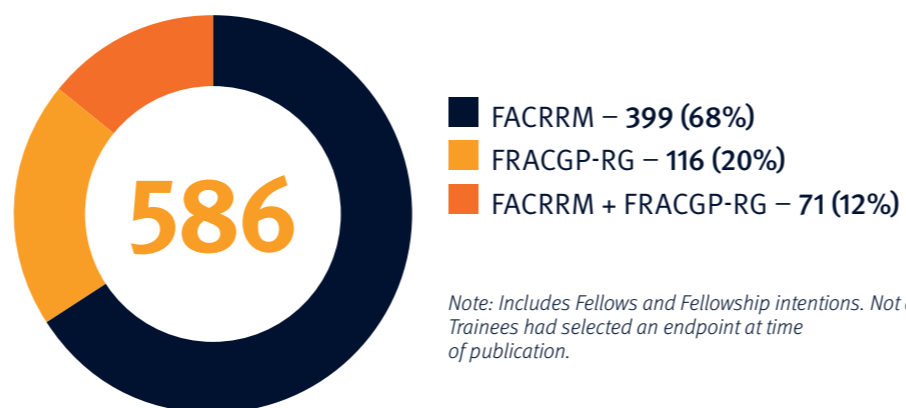

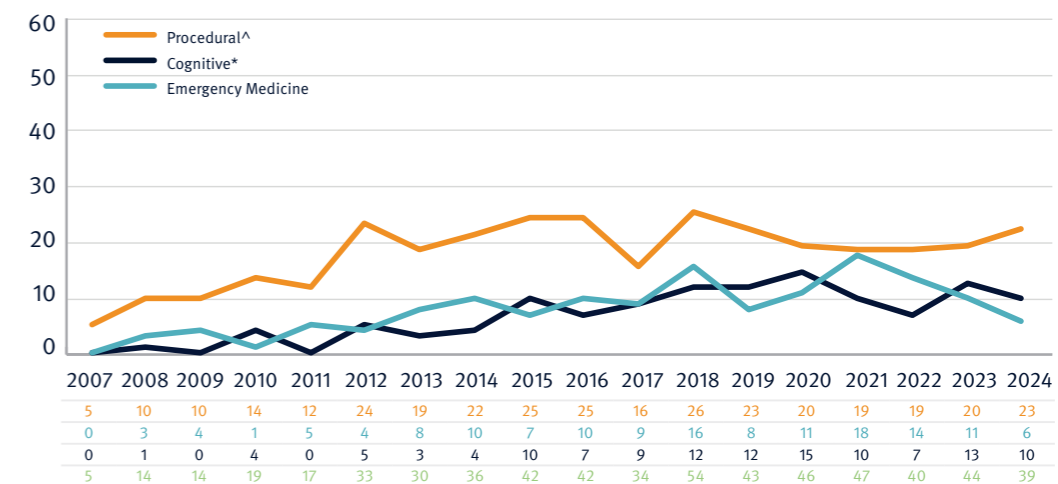
