

Oral Maxillofacial Surgery (OMS) is a challenging specialty that combines dental, medical and surgical knowledge and skills, and requires extensive study in a rigorous training program. Selection onto the OMS Training Program must be made directly to [The Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons](#) (RACDS).

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the [RMO Campaign](#) and preference as per below.

If you are on or have applied to RACFS, at **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, you **MUST** complete your preference by selecting the following:
