Queensland Basic Physician Training (Adult Medicine) Network



Planning for continuation of Physician Training

All applicants wishing to undertake basic physician training in Queensland must join the Basic Physician Training (Adult Medicine) Network. Network trainees are allocated training placements geared towards preparing for exams in the third year on the network. You may be able to sit the exam earlier however, if there is available training capacity. Support to sit the exam before this time will be considered on a case-by-case basis" in consideration of training capacity and available exam preparation resources.

If you are applying to join the network to CONTINUE TRAINING, you are required to:

- consider which <u>network rotation</u> may best suit your needs. Some rotations may be better placed to accommodate an earlier examination attempt AND
- discuss your plan for continuation of training, including outstanding RACP requirements and anticipated exam date with a Network Rotation Coordinator (NRC)
- Ask the NRC to complete and sign this form
- Submit your application through the <u>Resident Medical Officer (RMO) and Registrar campaign</u> within the <u>specified dates</u>
- Upload the signed form as part of application
