RMO and Registrar Campaign

Selection to General Surgery SET 2-5 Registrar positions are managed by the [Royal Australasian College of Surgeons](#) (RACS). Applicants need to apply directly to RACS for a [training position in General Surgery](#).

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the [RMO Campaign](#) and preference as per below.

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, to be considered you **MUST** complete your preference by selecting the following:
