RMO and Registrar Campaign

Applicants who wish to apply for Sexual health positions **recruited directly by Queensland Health facilities** are advised to preference positions at the following facilities in their order of personal interest. To be selected onto the <u>Sexual Health Medicine Advanced Training</u> <u>Program</u> with the <u>Royal Australasian College of Physicians</u> (RACP), new and continuing trainees must first secure a position within an accredited training facility.

In Queensland, to secure an accredited training position, applicants MUST submit an application via <u>RMO Campaign</u> and preference according to the positions on the <u>Position</u> <u>search tool</u>.
