## Cardiothoracic surgery preference guide

RMO and Registrar Campaign

Selection to the SET program in Cardiothoracic surgery in Australian and New Zealand are managed by the <u>Royal Australasian College of Surgeons</u> (RACS). Applicants need to apply directly to RACS for a <u>training position in Cardiothoracic surgery</u>.

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the <u>RMO Campaign</u> and preference as per below.

## **RMO application: Step 10 Preferences**

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, if you have applied to the college and to be allocated by your facility, you **MUST** complete your preference as follows:

You have 5 preferences available to use for positions, it is recommended that you utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions you may be interested in if you are not selected to your preferred position.
