

# Cardiothoracic surgery preference guide

## RMO and Registrar Campaign

Selection to the SET program in Cardiothoracic surgery in Australian and New Zealand are managed by the [Royal Australasian College of Surgeons](#) (RACS). Applicants need to apply directly to RACS for a [training position in Cardiothoracic surgery](#).

In Queensland, for an employment contract to be issued by your allocated training facility, applicants **MUST ALSO** submit an application via the [RMO Campaign](#) and preference as per below.

## RMO application: Step 10 Preferences

At **Step 10: Preferences** of the online RMO application, if you have applied to the college and to be allocated by your facility, you **MUST** complete your preference as follows:

You have 5 preferences available to use for positions, it is recommended that you utilise a lower preference to indicate which positions you may be interested in if you are not selected to your preferred position.
