Course aims

Designed as an adjunct to hospital-based clinical exam preparation, this course aims to provide participants with:

- a broad overview of major issues and recommended learning for the paediatric clinical exam
- practical advice from topic experts for long and short case preparation and management
- helpful tips and tricks to improve skills and performance for the exam.

At the end of the program, it is anticipated that participants will be able to:

- identify the standard expected for the RACP clinical exam
- refine their approach to the long case and the short case
- identify unique aspects of the approach to both the long and short case for key subspecialties.
